## Willie and Susie Tolbert Family Scholarship Eligibility Criteria

The Tolbert Scholarship is an up to a four-year Scholarship that will be awarded annually to a college bound student. For consideration of this scholarship, candidates must be:

- Applicant must be a member of The Liberty Baptist Church of Chicago for 2 years prior to being awarded (i.e., for a 2025-26 Scholarship, LBCC membership is required the years 2024 and 2025)
- Applicant must be actively involved in Liberty Baptist Church of Chicago programs and/or activities
- Applicant must be a high school graduate in the Chicago area who has maintained a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 (on 4.0 scale)
- Applicant must be actively involved in high school extracurricular activities/programs and/or volunteering in the community
- Letters of Recommendation: Candidates must provide two (2) letters of recommendation:
  - One (1) Letter from a high school administrator, faculty member, coach, or club advisor; and
  - One (1) Letter from an LBCC Leader (i.e., Pastor, Youth Pastor, Deacon, Trustee). Note: The LBCC Leader may not be a member of the Scholarship Aid Committee

## **Checklist**

- Fully completed Liberty Baptist Church Scholarship application. (Incomplete and/or late applications will not be *considered*).
- Copy of official academic transcript reflecting applicant's most recent semester grade point average.
- Two letters of recommendation, *preferably*, one of which should be from a current or past teacher or professor with whom you have had classes, and the other from a Liberty Baptist Church member or official.
- Recommendations from family members are <u>NOT</u> acceptable.
